COUNCIL NEWS

As Anna is away this month here is a quick note to keep you all up to date with things going on around your town.

There will be a seating trial in the main street with seating to be placed at the front of Farmer Jacks (1), at the northern end of the Police station lawn (1) and the Park in front of the pool (2).

This is part of the Revitalisation Plan and we are sure that there will be more recommendations from that plan implemented in the future.

There will be an Extraordinary Election held to fill the vacant position on Council. The Election Day will be Friday 16 January 2015. For further information refer advertisement this issue all inquiries to the returning officer.

A tenderer has been appointed for the construction of the new Gym and work is anticipated to start early 2015. The Gym will be located behind the Recreation Centre at the Sport precinct.

The recent council workshop agreed that finding an anchor tenant for the Lloyds Building was highly unlikely and therefore decided that the following would be housed in the building CRC/Bank, Café, Art Gallery possibly the library and Museum from the Shire office. This will all be subject to assessment of space and layout options.

These businesses would be located in the old supermarket area being the more modern construction. The old parts of the building would be set aside for a museum type area to better display the many old photos and other items of the area.

Consultation with the various intended users will continue as to their requirements before a consultant is employed to design a suitable floor plan.

Properties

There are a number of properties with Meekatharra that are under the notice of the Shire. Some are vandalised and some have been affected by fire. The Shire is currently attempting to get the owners of these properties to take appropriate action to secure, demolish, or carry out maintenance on them to bring them back to an acceptable standard.

The Shire is very mindful of the financial costs of such and is doing all in its power to give people enough time to fix the defects and make the building habitable. This process may appear slow to those of us just “watching” what is going on, but we need to allow the owners enough time to fix things up.

Lastly the Shire office will be closed over the Christmas /New Year period from the 25 December 2014 to the 5 January 2015.
