Meeka To Carnarvon Road Upgrade

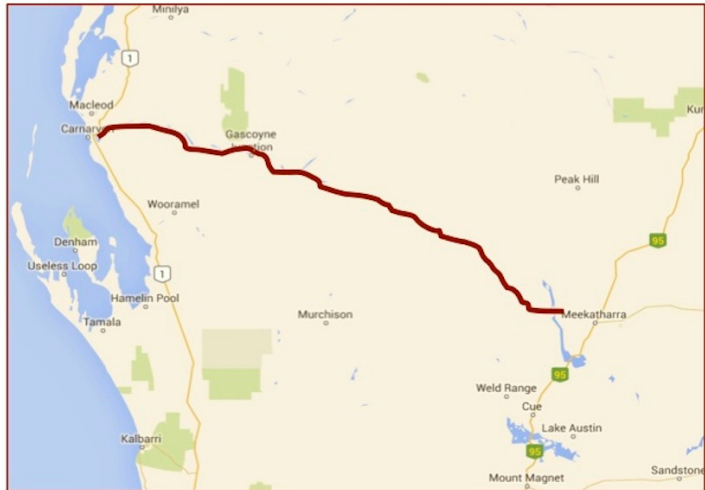
Royalties For Regions Grant Paves the Way

Meekatharra and points west could be getting a lot busier in the not so distant future, thanks to a Mid West Investment Plan grant of 3 million dollars to assist in sealing sections of the Meekatharra - Carnarvon route (the Lander road).

With a reputation for being a bit of a bone-shaker in places, the route provides access through some beautiful outback country to popular destinations such as the historic Mt. Gould lockup, Mt. Augustus, Lander Station and the world famous Lander Races, Kennedy Range National Park, and the wealth of marine must-sees that line the region's western coast. The upgrade will also provide improved connections to the Wool Wagon and Miners Pathways and the Kingsford-Smith Mail Run routes, which are also very popular visitor attractions.

The improvements will be welcome news to travellers, miners, pastoralists and locals alike - the area west of Meekatharra was identified by the Royalties for Regions Mid West Investment Plan as a "high priority" project essential to the increasingly busy mid west region. While the road is generally in good shape thanks to dedicated shire maintenance, the upgrade will help give everyone a safer, more comfortable journey - and perhaps save on a few tyres!

The construction of 20 kilometres of "Type 5 standard road" will take place over three financial years, starting in 2015/16, over two stages. Each stage will be constructed in approximately three to four kilometre sections, i.e. about seven kilometres per financial year. Meeka locals who remember what the road was like at our end before the sealing of the 30 km town approach can attest to the difference every sealed section makes, especially in flood season.

With increasing visitor numbers and the realisation of the economic potential of tourism, as well as renewed interest in mining opportunities as new technologies become available, projects such as road improvements can make an enormous difference to our future.

Australia has a vibrant tourism industry, with a solid combination of overseas visitors and interstate travellers. Our regional area also has the advantage of short term contract workers such as teachers, police and others who also make up a substantial part of our visitor numbers as they use their time off to explore the areas they're posted to, and of course there are our prospectors and road nomads, who also make annual visits. Improving access to some of our key regional spots means there's plenty for newcomers and returning visitors to see and do.

Mid West Investment Benefits Meeka

The Mid West Investment Plan (MWIP) is part of the Royalties For Regions approach in assisting with "major infrastructure projects and initiatives" to support a more "sustainable social and economic base" for our region. The grant for improving the Landor Road is just one of many projects being funded through the MWIP.

Other projects announced for funding include the Murchison Radioastronomy Observatory power station, the Yalgoo Community Sports Hub, Morawa Town Centre Revitalisation, the Original Railway Building Restoration and Carnamah & Eneabba Town Revitalisation Projects, to name just a few.

Another project receiving funding is the Meekatharra - Wiluna Road, which has been slated for a \$10 million contribution. This is another busy regional road which sees increasing local and visitor traffic every year, and which also suffers from chronic bad stretches when our rainy season rolls in.

The Meeka - Wiluna Road is growing ever more important for our tourism economy as we see more and more people wanting to tackle the Gunbarrel and other outback adventure treks. This tourist season saw large numbers of trail bike groups coming through Meeka, heading for the Wiluna and remote interior areas, as well as tagalong tours and individual travellers. Meekatharra is a popular stop-over and supply point for these travellers.

There is a growing interest in station-stay and "off the main highway" holidays in our region, and road improvements mean that pastoralists can more readily consider tourism as a supplementary form of income, providing not only a financial boost, but also promoting the importance of rural economies and the appeal of the outback lifestyle.

Prospectors - individuals, social groups and tours - increasingly use Meekatharra as a base for their activities; Paddy's Flat accommodation centre in McCleary Street sees regular tour group bookings each year, for example, and being able to confidently access our regional roads and tracks and discover "new patches" are of key importance to these types of visitors.

The Mid West Investment Plan's funding of regional road improvements and other projects reflects an overall understanding that W.A. is not only rich in mining resources, but also has a wealth of natural and historic appeal which, with the right types of investment and revitalisation, offer a diverse range of future opportunities and growth for our region.

REGISTRATION OF INTEREST

Registrations of interest are called for the design and provision of streetscape cut out panels.

Construction

The panels should be constructed of robust materials, be HIGHLY resistant to vandalism and low maintenance.

Design

The design should give the impression of activity in the town centre. Examples of similar panels are shown below; there is no requirement to follow these designs. Your design may include seating or a waterless garden. Cultural or historical images should not be used.

Locations

- Main Street outside of the Lloyds building.
- Main Street outside of the Old Bank building near Centre link.

Size

The height of the panels should not exceed 2.1m

The width is up to the provider but should be relative to the area of the installation.

Each art work may consist of more than one panel to achieve an overall design.

When registering your interest you should submit a concept design and an estimate of costs including installation. Council will consider both the design and cost as part of its decision.
